COUNTRY BOARDING

- All vaccinations are up to date. Bordetella, if given, was given **at least 2 weeks** prior to your dogs boarding stay. (After a Bordetella vaccination, dogs are possibly contagious for two weeks.)
- A copy (for me to keep) of current vaccination records from your vet.
- Dog's food, labeled with instructions, and in Ziploc bags or a sealed container. **Please bring extra food** in case of a travel delay. If I need to pick up more food for you, a \$.55.5 per mile surcharge will be incurred. It is 78 miles round trip from my house to Brandow's Feed & Seed!
- Do you normally feed your dog table scraps? I will do that too, if you bring me Individual freezer bags packed with up to 3 days worth of the food you would like me to add to your dog's meals. I'll thaw out their food every 3 days, so it stays nice and fresh.
- Medications and or supplements if applicable, labeled with your dog's name and instructions.
- Topical flea and tick preventative (Frontline/Advantix/or similar product) has been applied to your dog on a monthly basis. If fleas or ticks are found on your dog, we will bring your dog to our veterinarian for boarding at your expense. **We cannot jeopardize the safety of our other dogs.** I hope you understand.
- Toys, or something your dog likes to play with that can safely be left with him or her.
- Something that smells like you – a shirt, a blanket – that you can leave in the kennel for your dog's comfort.
